1. INFORMATION

2. LEGAL REGULATION APPLICABLE TO THE CONTRACT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS

These General Conditions are subject to whatever results from the application of the Royal Legislative Decree (R.D.L). 1/2007 of November 16th, which approves the revised text of the General Law for the Defense of Consumers and Users, Law 7/1998 of April 13th, on General Conditions of Contracting, and the Civil Code. The present General Conditions, signed by the contracting parties, will be incorporated into all contracts of the KING'S COLLEGE, S.L. Program, the object of which are the program contained in the information sheets and are binding on the parties, together with the particular conditions agreed in the contract and those which may be established in each program.

3. REGISTRATION, PRICE AND PAYMENT

In order to register for the chosen program, you must complete the registration form from KING'S COLLEGE S.L. with the corresponding reservation. There are some programs with different requirements or forms that must be added to the general conditions mentioned above for the participant to complete and sign.

Any request for enrolment in any of our programs must be accompanied by a payment for administrative expenses to the value of: **€300 for non residential and residential courses**. The amount paid on account will be deducted from the total price of the Program. The payment of the amounts referred to in the previous point should be made to the following account (always indicating the name and surname of the participant):

No program registration will be processed unless accompanied by proof of payment. The balance of the price of the contracted Program must be paid 30 days before the start of that program. Any failure to pay, both in time and method, will be considered as a waiver of the pupil to attend the course. Registrations made less than 30 days prior to the Program start date must pay the full amount of the chosen program at the time of registration. Registrations are personal and non-transferable.

4. CANCELLATION, NO PRESENTATION AND/OR ABANDONMENT OF THE PROGRAMME BY THE CUSTOMER

In the event that the customer decides to cancel the contracted Program, they must notify KING'S COLLEGE, S.L in writing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the customer must pay KING'S COLLEGE S.L. the amount corresponding to any damages caused, including all types of expenses incurred by KING'S COLLEGE, S.L, up to the current date. By way of example, but not limited to: payments to third parties involved in the program: schools, residences, monitors, teachers, telephone calls, amongst others. In order to inform the customer of the amount of retentions or charges to be made by withdrawal they shall amount to:


- 25% of the program price, if the cancellation occurs between 44 and 30 days from the course start date
- 50% of the program price, if the cancellation occurs between 29 and 10 days from the course start date.
- 75% of the program price, if the cancellation occurs within 9 days prior to the course start date.
- 100% in case of a no-show at departure.

The administration fees indicated in section two (2) of these general conditions must be paid to KING'S COLLEGE, S.L. in any case and, likewise, will not be refunded in any case, except if the cancellation insurance is taken out. Notwithstanding, if the customer withdraws from the contract during a period of 7 days from its execution, KING'S COLLEGE S.L. will return them the amounts paid without withholding expenses. The customer shall not be entitled to any refund if they, their parents or their legal guardians voluntarily leave the Program once said Program has commenced.

5. COVID Peace of mind Policy

At King's College Summer Camps, we are committed to ensuring everyone's safety and comfort, from our campers and staff to the communities and countries that host our camps. This summer, you can book a KC Summer Camp safe in the knowledge that we have worked with local authorities and implemented policies and procedures to ensure our camps provide the safest environment for your child. In addition to being confident that our camps meet strict government standards for safety and increased hygiene, we also offer you the security of being able to cancel your camp booking if COVID19 prevents travel*.

**We will transfer your registration to summer 2023 or offer a full refund of the camp fees in these circumstances: Student cannot travel to camp due to contracting Covid19†; Student is unable to travel to Summer Camp due to travel restrictions or quarantine caused by Covid19†; Summer Camp registrations do not reach the minimum number required. † Proof of positive test or quarantine may be required.*

6. Force Majeure

In the event that due to circumstances beyond the control of King's College Soto de Viñuelas, including any urgent government instruction, or cause of force majeure (natural disaster, war, health emergency including the pandemic and any outbreak of a pandemic) arising after the signing of this Agreement, if it becomes necessary to establish additional hygiene, mobility restriction, health, sanitary or safety measures that may force the suspension of the activity, King's College Soto de Viñuelas will provide the option to transfer your registration to summer 2023 or offer a full refund of the camp fees in these circumstances".

7. ALTERATIONS AND OCCURRENCES IN THE PROGRAMME

Airport pick up services: the flight information (date, hour and flight number) must be confirmed in writing at least 7 working days prior arrival. The airport transfer service operates between 08.00 and 18.00 local time. In case of flight changes without previous notification, King's College Soto de Viñuelas will not be held responsible for collecting the student at the airport.

KING'S COLLEGE S.L. undertakes to provide customers with all contracted services contained within the program, with the stipulated conditions and characteristics. Notwithstanding, the following considerations should be taken into account: (a) In the event that, prior to the start of the Program, KING'S COLLEGE S.L. are forced to significantly alter any essential part of the contract, including the price, they must immediately bring it to the attention of the customer. The latter may choose to terminate the contract without charge or accept an amendment to the contract. In the latter case KING'S COLLEGE S.L. will specify any modifications introduced and their repercussion on the price of the Program. (b) The customer shall notify their decision as soon as possible and, in any case, within three days of being notified of the change in the Program. In the event that the customer does not notify KING'S COLLEGE S.L. of their decision within the three-day period, it will be understood that they choose to terminate the Program. (c) In the event that KING'S COLLEGE S.L. are obliged to cancel any of its Programs due to cases not attributable to the customer, or in the event that the customer chooses to terminate the contract under the protection of the provisions of paragraphs a) and b), KING'S COLLEGE S.L. will offer the customer an alternative Program of equal or higher quality, or will reimburse the customer for the total amount paid for the Program. In addition, in such cases KING'S COLLEGE S.L. shall indemnify the customer for breach of contract with the following amounts:

- 25% of the program price if the cancellation occurs between 44 and 30 days from the course start date.
- 50% of the program price, if the cancellation occurs between 29 and 10 days from the course start date.
- 75% of the program price, if the cancellation occurs within 9 days prior to the course start date.
- 100% in case of a no-show at departure.


(d) There will be no obligation on the part of KING'S COLLEGE S.L. to indemnify the customer when the program is cancelled due to reasons of force majeure. (e) There will be no obligation on the part KING'S COLLEGE S.L. to compensate customers in the event that the program cancellation is due to not reaching the minimum number of people required (10 participants) for the effective realization of the same. In such cases KING'S COLLEGE S.L. shall notify the customer in writing that the minimum number of participants has not been reached and that the program has therefore been cancelled. In this case, the customer is entitled to a refund of all amounts they have paid for the program. (f) Any differences and/or claims that, in the opinion of the customers, arise during the progress of the contracted Program shall be brought to the attention of the Organisation responsible for the Program, in order to offer a satisfactory solution immediately. In the event that the solution proposed by the Organisation responsible for the Program being conducted is not satisfactory to the customer, the latter shall have a period of one month to submit a claim in writing to KING'S COLLEGE S.L. They, having obtained the relevant documentation, would in turn have a period of one month to reply to the customer's complaint. If the solution proposed by KING'S COLLEGE S.L. was also not satisfactory, the customer may initiate any corresponding actions.

8. PRACTICES AND MANDATORY STANDARDS DURING THE PROGRESS OF THE PROGRAMME

The participant agrees to respect and abide by the course discipline and behavior rules, both during their stay in the facilities where they receive their lessons, and outside of them. In particular, in relation to opening times of the centre, the obligation of class attendance, meals, rules of coexistence and behavior with teachers, classmates, and staff employed by KING'S COLLEGE S.L. and the prohibition of consumption and possession of tobacco, alcohol and drugs. Failure on the part of the participant will result in their expulsion from the course, the expenses of the early return home being paid on their account.

9. MEDICAL, PHARMACOLOGICAL AND/OR SURGICAL TREATMENT

The participant shall inform KING'S COLLEGE S.L. if they are undergoing any medical and/or pharmacological treatment during the period covered by the chosen program. It is understood that, at the time of beginning the program, the participant is in correct physical and mental health to participate in the program and that the medical information accompanying the program dossier is true and

complete. Otherwise, the company KING'S COLLEGE S.L. is exempt from any type of liability arising from the falseness of the information.

In the event that a pupil of minor age is in a situation needing medical treatment and/or being admitted to hospital and/or in need of surgical intervention and it has not been possible to locate their parents or guardians, KING'S COLLEGE S.L. is hereby authorised to take the measures it deems most appropriate for the participant's health.

10. ELECTRONIC DEVICES

KING'S COLLEGE S.L. is not responsible for the loss and/or deterioration of any electronic devices that the participant may bring to the chosen program. KING'S COLLEGE S.L. will make contact telephone numbers available with a fixed timetable to contact the participants. KING'S COLLEGE S.L. will provide the calling schedule as well as the telephone numbers prior to the start of the program.

11. DOCUMENTATION


All participants who contract the programs of KING'S COLLEGE S.L. must carry the necessary personal documentation (ID card, health insurance card) in accordance with the laws of the country where the arranged program will occur. KING'S COLLEGE S.L. will not accept responsibility for any and all liability or expenses arising from failure to comply on the part of the participant, their parents or guardians.

12. INSURANCE

Participants who enrol in the programs of KING'S COLLEGE, S.L. can enjoy, if they so wish, fully comprehensive insurance cover according to the conditions of the insurance policy taken out by KING'S COLLEGE S.L. and provided by the company European Insurance. KING'S COLLEGE S.L. acts as a mere intermediary between the insurance company and the customers who contract any of our programs. Customers may contract another policy of their choice. In this case, they should make this circumstance known to KING'S COLLEGE S.L.

13. DATA PROTECTION

LATAM EDUCATION HOLDINGS, S.L., with VAT number B87232641 and registered address at Avda. Pío XII, 92, 28036 Madrid, Spain acting as the data controller in compliance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and the L.O. 3/2018, of December 5, on data protection and guarantee of digital rights (LOPDGDD), informs that the personal information collected through this Application Form is compiled

with the purpose of the provision, management and billing of summer camp activities. The data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfill the expressed purposes and legal obligations. Once the aforementioned period has elapsed, the data will be permanently deleted using the appropriate security measures. The data will not be communicated to third parties, except by legal obligation or for the execution of the service. You can exercise your rights of withdrawal of consent, access, rectification, object, erasure, limitation and portability of your data at any time by sending a written request and indicating in the subject "DATA PROTECTION", attaching your identification document to: dpo@kingsgroup.org. You also have the right to file a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Authority (www.aepd.es) if you consider that the data processing does not comply with current regulations. Minors. The aforementioned data protection regulations establish limitations on the processing of the personal data of a "minor". 14. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION AND IMAGE PROCESSING

14.1 Aim of the program. KING'S COLLEGE, S.L., as the data controller, with registered address at Paseo de los Andes 35, Soto de Viñuelas, 28760, Madrid, Spain, in compliance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation), informs the signatories of the registration form that their own personal data and, where applicable, that of the respective represented persons, that are requested through the form, as well as those that may be provided subsequently, including those relating to special categories if any, are necessary for compliance with the stipulations of these Terms and Conditions, as well as for the development, control and management of the training activity in which the participant has registered. The signatories guarantee the veracity of the data provided at all times and undertake to communicate promptly to KING'S COLLEGE S.L any variation thereof.

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the execution of these Terms and Conditions, as well as the fulfilment of legal obligations corresponding to KING'S COLLEGE S.L and the consent given by the signatories. If the signatories do not consent to the processing of their data, the participant will not be able to enjoy the training activity. In addition, in the event that the signatories check the boxes enabled for the purpose, they expressly authorise (i) KING'S COLLEGE S.L so that it can transfer personal data to other King's Group companies, and (ii) that both companies process the personal data so that either of them can send commercial communications by any means, including telephone, e-mail or equivalent means of communication, about products, services and promotions in the field of

educational and cultural services. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the signatories may withdraw their express consent for any of the additional purposes envisaged and, in particular, for the receipt of commercial communications, at any time, in writing via email addressed to dpo@kingsgroup.org.


14.2 Data retention. The data provided will be kept with the appropriate technical and organizational measures that guarantee the appropriate level of security and for the time that is necessary, in order to guarantee compliance with the legal obligations that correspond to KING'S COLLEGE S.L during the necessary prescription periods depending on the applicable legislation. After the deadlines indicated, the data will be duly removed.

14.3 Data of third parties. In the event that personal data of third parties are provided by the signatories, they shall guarantee that they have informed such third parties and have obtained the necessary consent for their processing by KING'S COLLEGE S.L with the purposes detailed in this clause. KING'S COLLEGE S.L reserves the right to require the signatories, whose documentation provided includes the processing of third-party data, proving that they have met the aforementioned information and consent requirements.

14.4 Data communication. The signatories authorize KING'S COLLEGE S.L to transfer personal data through communication to entities that belong to the business group of which KING'S COLLEGE S.L. is a member at any time. Likewise, the collaborating organizations that perform services related to the content of the training activity and that help KING'S COLLEGE S.L in this regard may have access to the participant's data, in order to process and control the good development and execution of the training activity.

14.5 International data transfer. The information that the signatories provide to KING'S COLLEGE S.L for the execution of this contract can be transferred internationally to other KING'S GROUP centers and to the INSPIRED Group in which it is integrated as well as to third parties for their processing in accordance with the requirements established by the legislation applicable in each country and / or region and to the applicable international agreements where the different entities of the aforementioned groups operate. In this regard, KING'S COLLEGE S.L acting as data controller or data processor, depending on the position, will protect the rights of signatories in international data transfers to third countries, observing at all times the Group's security standards and legal requirements. On the other hand, KING'S COLLEGE S.L will apply the Binding Corporate Rules (or "BCR") that offer adequate protection guarantees to make transfers between the Group companies and that would be applicable in the place where the regulations contemplate it.

KC Soto also informs the signatories that their data will not be transferred to any third parties except when required in the framework of compliance with legal obligations by the administrations or

competent official bodies that require it, as well as where appropriate, to data processors that will require it for the execution of this contract.

14.6 Security measures. KING'S COLLEGE S.L has implemented the necessary technical and organizational security measures that guarantee the security of your personal data and prevent its alteration, loss, unauthorised processing and / or access, taking into account the state of the technology, the nature of the stored data and the risks to which they are exposed, already come from human action or from the physical or natural environment.

14.7 Rights. The signatories may, under the terms established in the regulations on data protection in force at any time, and in accordance with the regulations, revoke at any time the authorisation granted for the processing and transfer of personal data, as well as exercise the rights of access, rectification, erasure, object, right to request the limitation of the processing of personal data, the right to portability and the right to file a claim with a supervisory authority. To do this, they may send a request to KING'S COLLEGE S.L in writing with a proof of their identity at Paseo de los Andes 35, Soto de Viñuelas, 28760, Madrid, Spain, or by email to info@kingsgroup.org.

14.8 Image. In order to disseminate the training activities that KING'S COLLEGE S.L carries out, the signatories and the participant are informed that, during their enjoyment, photographs and / or video recordings of the participant may be made, being the intention of KING'S COLLEGE S.L to publish those images and / or video recordings in media, conventional and / or electronic, to publicise their activities always in strict compliance with Organic Law 1/1982, of May 5, on Civil Protection of the Right to Honor, Personal and Familiar Privacy and the Image Rights and the applicable regulations regarding data protection.

Therefore, in this application form, the consent of the participant or, where appropriate, their legal representatives will be requested so that KING'S COLLEGE S.L is allowed to use and / or disseminate the participant's image for a limited time and in accordance with the purposes set forth in this section for promotional purposes and in KING'S COLLEGE S.L exclusive media such as press material, newsletters, web pages, social networks and / or other similar media on the Internet (all of them owned and used exclusively by KC) and its use and & or dissemination is prohibited by other means or third parties not authorised and outside KING'S COLLEGE S.L In any case, the participant or their legal representatives may withdraw their consent at any time and free of charge in accordance with the provisions of current legislation.

14.9 Minors. The European Regulation and national data protection laws establish limitations on the processing of the personal data of a "minor". Therefore, KING'S COLLEGE S.L provides that all data processing of a minor must have the authorisation of their parent or guardian, which will be duly accredited and in accordance with the applicable regulations.

15. RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS

Any conflict related to the programs will be resolved by the competent jurisdictional bodies according to the applicable legislation.

16. VALIDITY

The validity of these general conditions will be from January the First, 2021 to December the 31st, 2021 both inclusive.
